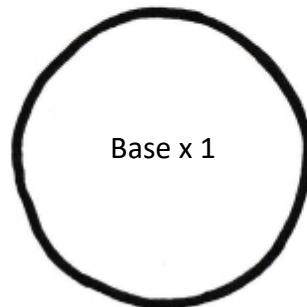
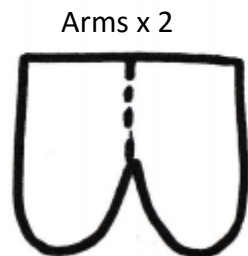
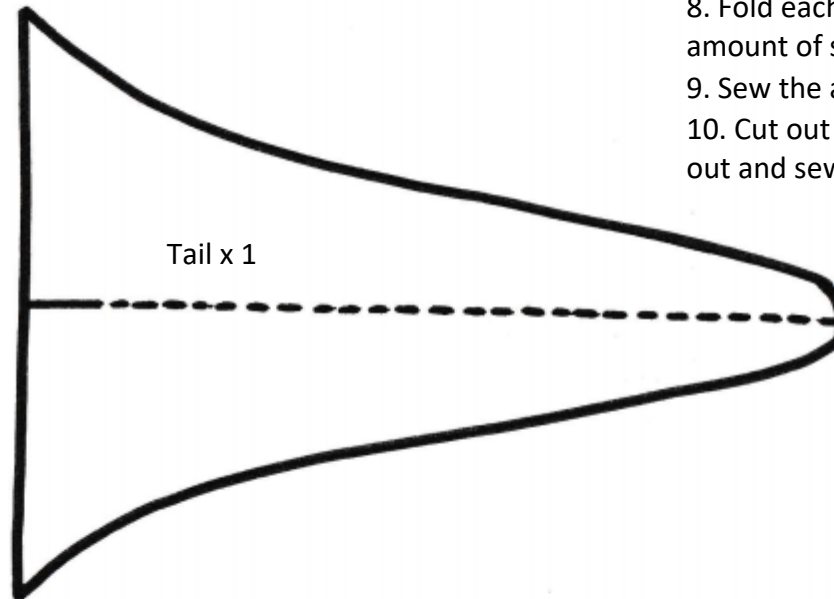
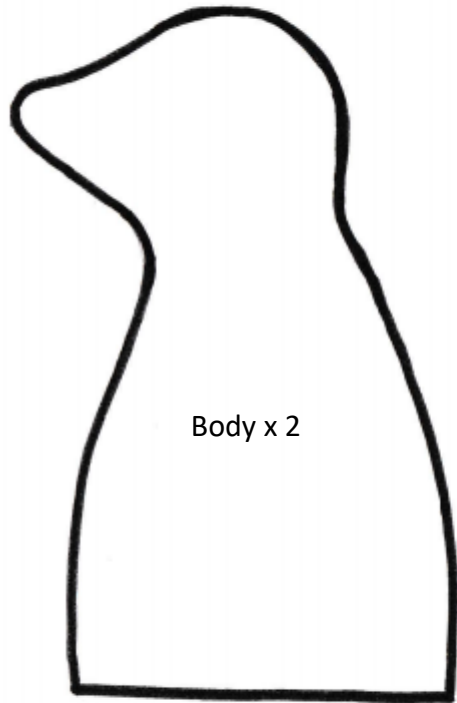




Felt standing pangolin

1. Print and cut out the pattern.
2. Pin the pattern to the felt and cut out the pieces.
3. Use black thread to sew small eyes onto the body pieces, taking care to sew them in the same place on each piece.

4. Fold the tail in half along the dotted line. Using blanket stitch, sew along the long edge starting at the tip of the tail.
5. Sew the two body pieces together starting at the belly. As you sew down the back, pin the tail in place and sew it onto the body.
6. Fill the tail and body with stuffing.
7. Sew the base on. Include a circle of card or a coin to help keep the base flat.
8. Fold each arm in half and sew together, adding a small amount of stuffing.
9. Sew the arms in place.
10. Cut out and sew the scales on, starting at the tail. I cut out and sewed on 20 scales at a time.
